BOX CONCERTS BLOCK PARTY FAQs

What do I need to do host a Box Concerts Block Party?

Host a Box Concerts this summer!

Gather at least 25 neighbours to attend.

Flyer your street and post it on your neighbourhood's FB or WhatsApp group. Tapestry Opera will provide printer-friendly flyers.

What does Box Concerts need?

A parking space no less than 10 feet wide x 25 feet long in front, beside, or behind your building or home (roughly two parking spaces).

A grounded power outlet and a long extension cord are helpful but unnecessary.

How long does a Box Concert last?

About 30 minutes.

Where do I sit?

On your front porch, driveway, or doorstep, wherever makes the most sense to you!

What will happen on the day?

The Box Concerts Production Coordinator will contact you in advance to confirm the time and

location of the performance. The Box Concerts team will arrive 30 minutes before the concert start time to park the trailer stage, meet the contact(s) and set up the stage. The team consists of two people: the performer and the production coordinator. Set-up will take approximately 20 minutes: the team must unpack the stage, plug in the equipment to the outlet you provide, and perform a brief soundcheck.

What if it rains?

The production coordinator will determine if the Box Concert can take place pending the weather conditions on the day of the Box Concert and will contact you if they cannot proceed. If that happens, the Box Concert coordinator, Dona, will contact you to arrange a later date if available.
